EDITORIAL

In today's increasingly global environment, Mediterranean and neighbouring countries are facing new challenges in terms of healthcare. They express new expectations and requirements in terms of modernisation of their social welfare systems, the optimisation of patient support, and even the accreditation of hospitals.

Meanwhile, the French healthcare system is often praised and its hospital expertise (in terms of healthcare, research, training, etc.) is increasingly sought.

In this context, France needs to be able to support the development of Mediterranean and neighbouring countries' healthcare systems in an even more structured and proactive manner than it does today.

As a result, hospital professionals and their institutional and industrial partners have decided to take action by launching a brand new event: HopitalExpo Méditerranée.

A trade show combined with an international convention, HopitalExpo Méditerranée will be a meeting point for government officials, hospital managers, project leaders, donors, private funders, medical researchers and healthcare manufacturers.
